This Memorandum of Understanding between University of the Republic of Uruguay and the South Australian Research and Development Institute (SARDI) signifies mutual interest in the development of joint educational and research projects. Where financially feasible and consistent with the policies of the SARDI Board, and all other governing legislation, the parties agree to pursue their mutual interest in the following types of activities:

- Long term and short term exchanges of research and faculty staff (e.g. sabbaticals, faculty improvement leaves, visiting professorships)
- Research collaboration and other activities in areas of mutual interest and expertise are contemplated.
- Programs relating to research, teaching, and/or outreaching. Such programs may/encompass any
  discipline to the extent that suitable counterparts exist at the other institution
- Exchange of students at the graduate level.

Prior to arranging visits, developing projects, or exchanges, representatives at bothinstitutions shall secure approval from their respective department or section heads.

It is understood that neither party assumes any financial obligation as a result of this Memorandum of Understanding, but that financial arrangements will be negotiated separately and realisation of activities will depend upon the availability of funds.

The signatures of the institutional representatives affixed below signify the interest of both parties in promoting mutual friendship and cooperation. This understanding will remain in effect until one party notifies the other of its wish to terminate the agreement.
