

**GENERAL AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION**  
between

**School of Mechanical and Materials Engineering and  
School of Electrical Engineering and Information Technology,  
KUNGL TEKNISKA HÖGSKOLAN**  
Stockholm, Sweden  
and  
**Facultad de Ingenieria,  
UNIVERSIDAD DE LA REPUBLICA**  
Montevideo, Uruguay

**Preamble**

In furtherance of their mutual interests in the fields of education and research, Kungl Tekniska Högskolan (KTH), represented by Professor Janne Carlsson and Facultad de Ingenieria, Universidad de la Republica (FIA), represented by Professor Jorge Broveto, hereby agree as follows.

In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise implies, Home University shall mean the university at which the student intends to graduate; Host University shall mean the university which has agreed to receive students from the Home University.

**Article 1**

The aim of this Agreement is to define the framework of common measures to be taken by KTH and FIA in order to promote the exchange of persons, activities and experience in relevant fields of higher education and research.

**Article 2**

KTH and FIA shall co-operate in fields of teaching and research to be agreed upon between their schools subject to the provisions of this Agreement. Within the fields to be mutually designated, both Universities agree to the following general forms of cooperation.

**Article 3**

Participating students under this Agreement will be enrolled as non-degree students at the Host University. Credits will be transferred to the Home University with a transcript of results provided to the Home University as soon as possible after the completion of the exchange.

**Article 4**

The exchange of students under this Agreement will be conducted in accordance with the following principles:

- both Universities agree to waive tuition charges for incoming students;
- the selection of exchange students will be made by mutual agreement and by following the appropriate steps as required by each of the Universities. The students must have completed at least two years of academic studies at the Home University.
- the students will be responsible for covering the travel costs to the host country and living costs during the stay, including accommodation, books, equipment, consumable, health insurance, student union fee and other expenses arising out of the exchange;
- the Host University will render assistance to the incoming students in finding appropriate accommodation;
- students participating under the terms of this exchange will be entitled to participate in any introductory programs that may customarily be arranged for foreign students.

#### Article 5

Students participating under this Agreement shall be subject to the rules and regulations to the Host University. They will also have the rights and privileges enjoyed by other students enrolled at the Host University.

#### Article 6

KTH will send up to two exchange students to FIA each year and FIA will send up to two exchange students to KTH each year during the term of this Agreement.

#### Article 7

Each University will nominate its own representative within each field of cooperation, and such representative will be responsible for all measures to be undertaken under this Agreement. The representatives will provide advisory and other academic services to students participating under this Agreement.

#### Article 8

This Agreement shall come into effect on the day of approval of both Universities and shall have a duration of three years. This Agreement may be terminated by either University provided that written notice of the intent is given at least six months prior to termination. Commitments already in progress shall be fulfilled.

#### Article 9

Amendments or changes to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorised representatives of the Universities.

This Agreement has been signed in duplicate, of which each University has taken one.


