AGREEMENT OF DOCTORATE CO-TUTORSHIP

ADDENDUM N°1

Ecole Normale Supérieure de Cachan (here below ENS Cachan), established in 61, avenue du Président Wilson, 94235 Cachan cedex (France), represented by its president Pierre-Paul ZALIO,

and

Universidad de la República, established at *1968, Avenida 18 de Julio, Montevideo, URUGUAY*, hereinafter named « **UR** »,

Hereafter called « the Parties »

Signed on *11/2010* an agreement of joint doctorate, hereafter called « the Agreement », for a duration of three years, concerning the student:

José LEZAMA, born on *02/05/1983*, in *Paris, FRANCE*

Preamble

Considering the wish of the student, *José LEZAMA*, and of his N° PhD co-supervisors, *Prof. Jean-Michel Morel* (CMLA, ENS Cachan) and *Prof. Gregory Randall (Facultad de Ingeniería, UR)* to modify the dates of *the defense*.

The Parties decide:

Article 1

The PhD student will only pay the registration fee in one of the two partner institutions following this schedule:

- 4th year, payment of the registration and tuition fee at UR, (the PhD student is exempted from the registration fees by ENS Cachan).
- 5th year, payment of the registration and tuition fee at ENS Cachan, (the PhD student is exempted from the registration fees by UR).

Article 2


The defense will be held in Cachan, France before 06/2015 unless otherwise agreed between the parties.




