Damià Barceló Culleres, with Spanish identity document number 40847495R as Director of the Fundació Institut Català de Recerca de l'Aigua (hereinafter, ICRA), with registered offices at C/ Emili Grahit, 101, Edificio H2O, 17003 Girona.

Gonzalo Vicci Gianotti, with passport number YB2975327 as President of the International Relations Service of Universidad de la República (hereinafter, Origin Institution), with registered offices at Av. 18 de Julio 1824, 11200 Montevideo, Uruguay.

Valeria Vázquez, with passport number YB0680924 as student (hereinafter, Collaborator) of Facultad de Química-Udelar, Uruguay

Sara Rodríguez Mozaz, with Spanish Identity Document (DNI) or Foreigner's Identity Document (NIE) number 33445144Q, as an employee of the Fundació Institut Català de Recerca de l'Aigua and as Responsible/Supervisor at ICRA of the Collaborator Valeria Vázquez.

The parties acknowledge the necessary legal capacity to formalise this agreement, and,

THEY STATE

- I. That ICRA is recognised as a Public R&D&i Centre. Its objectives are to develop research, innovation and knowledge transfer projects for all aspects relating to the water cycle.
- II. That ICRA and the Origin Institution have their own legal status, which enables them to enter into this Collaboration Agreement for better compliance of its entrusted purposes.
- III. That to achieve greater effectiveness in its respective areas of action, both institutions deem it necessary to implement research collaboration initiatives.
- IV. That Origin Institution is connected with the Collaborator as student (student, employee, etc.).
- V. That the Catalan Institute for Water Research Foundation (ICRA) accepts the Collaborator's stay, which will be governed by the following

AGREEMENTS

Purpose of the agreement

The purpose of this Agreement is to promote collaboration in the research areas between the signatory Parties and, bearing in mind that the Parties share common interests and objectives in scientific and cultural areas, such as promoting and developing research and transfer in the field of water, the Parties agree to sign this Collaboration Agreement.





Obligations of the parties

Of the Collaborator:

- Make the most of the stay for their own benefit, that of Origin Institution and ICRA.
- They undertake not to disseminate the scientific and/or technical information belonging to the
 other party, or the content of data or any report that has been drawn up during its execution and
 to which they may have had access due to its confidential nature.
- The Collaborator may access ICRA (H2O Building) during the official opening hours of the centre, having to assume the obligation to comply with and follow all the organisation, functioning, environmental, security and emergency rules that are indicated. In the event of non-compliance of these rules, ICRA is authorised to prohibit their entry to the installations.
- The Collaborator undertakes to preserve the integrity and good state of the ICRA installations and equipment to which they have access and are authorised to use.

Of ICRA:

- The ICRA Manager/Supervisor of the Collaborator undertakes to inform the latter of the organisation and functioning of the entity and the legislation of interest, particularly training and informing on matters relating to the Environment, Health and Safety at Work, and Emergencies.
- Offer the Collaborator information, training, support and, if appropriate, the necessary and suitable materials that make their stay more beneficial.

III. Duration of the Agreement

The duration of this Collaboration Agreement is established from 12 September 2022 until 12 December 2022.

IV. Of the Collaborator's administrative-legal situation

Considering their condition as an EU member state national or not, the Collaborator must do the relevant procedures to obtain the necessary authorisations (visas, etc.) so this Agreement is valid. They must also undertake to maintain the validity of their permit for the duration of this agreement. Should their residence permit become invalid in Spain, this must be immediately communicated to ICRA and Origin Institution and this agreement will be automatically rescinded.

V. Consideration

The realisation this stay will not accrue any economic consideration by ICRA, nor will it imply, under any circumstances, the existence of an employment relationship between the Collaborator and ICRA.





Medical Insurance and Public Liability VI.

The collaborator will contract health insurance at his/her own expense, which will include accident, illness and repatriation of remains.

VII. **Precautions regarding COVID-19**

Regarding COVID-19, the Origin Institution follows the recommendations of the health authorities and has an Action Plan for its personnel and has taken the necessary measures to prevent, to the extent possible, the transmission and spread of SARS-CoV-2.

It also undertakes to inform ICRA of any variation or circumstances that must be borne in mind, to carry out the necessary actions to guarantee everyone's health.

The Collaborator must certify their situation and background regarding COVID-19 through a Declaration of Responsibility.
